



Whole School Uniform Rules

We hope that our students take pride in wearing the school uniform that identifies them as a member of the Lewes Old Grammar School community.

Please note:

- Pupils are expected to look smart at all times.
- Any pupil temporarily not wearing the correct uniform requires a letter / email from a parent or guardian explaining the reason. This should be sent to the form tutor.
- Pupils who do not follow the uniform rules will receive sanctions.
- We have one uniform list for pupils in Year 7-9 and one uniform list for pupils in Year 10-11. Members of our senior school community are able to choose to wear trousers or a skirt and their choice of either a shirt and tie or a revere blouse.
- Every item of personal clothing should be named. Schoolblazer offers a name-taping service.
- Any items marked with an asterisk * must be purchased from Schoolblazer.
- Where it states (optional), this means that it is not compulsory to purchase.

Please read these rules carefully to avoid issues.

The following guidelines are to help ensure that students uphold the reputation of the school within the wider community.

All members of our community within a year group have the same uniform choices. Pupils may choose to wear trousers or a skirt with either a shirt and tie or a revere blouse. When you register on the Schoolblazer website, you will need to select the School and Year Group and complete your child's details. You are then asked for the sex of your child where you can select female, male or All Uniform. If you cannot see all of the items you require from your original selection, you can edit your details and change sex to 'All Uniform'.



Junior School Uniform

Pre-Reception School Uniform Dress Code

Tops

- School maroon polo shirt with coat of arms*
- School maroon sweatshirt with coat of arms*
- Grey cardigan with contrast Maroon V (optional)*
- Burgundy and White Stripe Summer Dress (optional)*

Trousers/Shorts

- Black jogging bottoms
- Black shorts

Other Uniform

- LOGS Black crested reversible school coat (compulsory)*
- Black waterproof jacket (optional)*
- Crested fleece hat* or winter hat (purchased from Junior School Office)
- Crested Legionnaires hat/cap*
- Book bag*

*** These items must be purchased from Schoolblazer. All items are compulsory unless otherwise stated**



Boys Junior School Uniform

Formal Uniform

- Maroon school blazer with coat of arms*
- Charcoal grey trousers or shorts to be worn on the waist
- If belts are worn these must be black, plain, not branded.

Shirts, Tie and Jumpers

- White shirt with buttons to the neck tucked in at all times
- Elasticated Tie* (Reception – Year 2)
- Junior School Tie* (Years 3-6)
- Grey 'V' neck jumper with contrast Maroon trim*.
- Grey Socks

Shoes

- Smart, plain black leather shoes which must be polished. Visible logos are not allowed.

Outerwear

- LOGS crested reversible school coat*
- Black waterproof jacket (optional)*
- School scarf (optional)*
- Crested fleece hat* or winter hat (purchased from Junior School Office)
- Crested cap* or sun hat (purchased from Junior School Office)
- Crested Book Bag* (Reception to Year 2)
- Crested Rucksack* (Year 3 – 6)
- Black waterproof trousers for forest school

*** These items must be purchased from Schoolblazer. All items are compulsory unless otherwise stated**

Jewellery

- No visible body piercings are allowed.
- No jewellery apart from watches.



Girls Junior School Uniform

Formal Uniform

- Maroon school blazer with school coat of arms*
- LOGS tartan Pinafore (Reception – Year 2)*, or Charcoal grey trousers or shorts to be worn on the waist
- LOGS tartan Kilt (Year 3 – 6)*, or Charcoal grey trousers or shorts to be worn on the waist
- Burgundy and White Stripe Summer Dress* (**All Years Summer Term**)

Blouses, Jumpers and Cardigans

- White reverse neck blouse (Shirts with a top button are not allowed).
- Grey cardigan or jumper with contrast Maroon trim*.
- No tie.

Shoes, Tights and Socks

- Smart, plain black leather or patent shoes which must be polished. Visible logos are not allowed.
- Grey tights or socks with tartan, trousers and shorts, and white ankle socks with summer dresses.

Outerwear

- LOGS crested reversible school coat*
- Black waterproof jacket (optional)*
- School scarf (optional)*
- Crested fleece hat* or winter hat (purchased from Junior School Office/winter & spring terms)
- Crested Cap* or sun hat (purchased from Junior School Office/summer term)
- Crested Book Bag*
- Crested Rucksack*
- Black waterproof trousers for forest school

*** These items must be purchased from Schoolblazer. All items are compulsory unless otherwise stated**

Jewellery

- Discreet jewellery consisting of a watch and a pair of matching plain stud earrings in each lobe is allowed. There must be absolutely no other visible piercing
- Chains, bracelets and rings are not permitted.
- Jewellery must be removed during Games and PE. Any jewellery is the pupils' responsibility, and the school will not be held responsible for loss or theft



Junior School PE Uniform

Reception to Year 2 Boys and Girls

Tops

- School maroon polo shirt with coat of arms*
- School maroon sweatshirt with coat of arms*
- House t-shirt*
 - Barbican House – Red
 - De Montfort House – Green
 - Malling House – Blue

Trousers/Shorts

- Black school jogging bottoms
- LOGS crested black shorts*

Footwear

- White short PE socks
- Black and maroon long games socks* (Year 2 only)
- White plimsolls or trainers



Year 3 to Year 6 Boys

Tops

- LOGS white and maroon polo shirt with school coat of arms*
- LOGS reversible black and maroon rugby shirt with school coat of arms*
- House t-shirt*
 - Barbican House – Red
 - De Montfort House – Green
 - Malling House - Blue

Bottoms

- LOGS crested black shorts*

Footwear

- Black and maroon long games socks*
- White short PE socks
- Football boots
- White plimsolls or trainers

Other Sports equipment

- LOGS base layer top and bottoms (compulsory Years 5-6)*
- LOGS black and maroon tracksuit top with school coat of arms*
- LOGS training pant bottoms*
- LOGS mid-layer top with school coat of arms*
- Shin pads
- Mouthguard (available from the Junior School Office)
- LOGS sports bag*



Year 3 to Year 6 Girls

Tops & Bottoms

- LOGS white and maroon polo shirt with school coat of arms*
- LOGS crested black shorts*, or LOGS black Skort (available from Junior School Office)
- House t-shirt*
 - Barbican House – Red
 - De Montfort House – Green
 - Malling House - Blue

Footwear

- Black and maroon long games socks*
- White short PE socks
- White plimsolls or trainers

Other sports equipment

- LOGS base layer top and bottoms (compulsory Years 5-6)*
- LOGS black and maroon tracksuit top with school coat of arms*
- LOGS training pant bottoms*
- LOGS mid layer with school coat of arms (optional)*
- Shin pads
- Mouthguard (available from the Junior School office)
- LOGS Sports Bag*



Senior School

Blazer, Skirt and Trousers

- Mid Grey school blazer or fitted jacket with school coat of arms*
- Charcoal Grey trousers to be worn on the waist – acceptable style shown on School Blazer website **OR** LOGS tartan kilt*. The kilt needs to be of a reasonable length, not too short. It should not be rolled up or shortened.
- If belts are worn with trousers, these must be black with plain, unbranded buckles.

Shirts, Tie and Jumpers

- White long/short sleeved shirt with buttons to the neck, tucked in at all times with school tie Year 7-9* (this option is usually worn with trousers) **OR** White open necked long/short sleeved revere blouse to be tucked in at all times and worn without a tie (this option is usually worn with a skirt).
- School tie Year 7 – 9*
- Maroon 'V' neck jumper with contrast grey trim*, sleeved or sleeveless*. No other jumpers may be worn.
- School blazers must be worn at all times and school jumpers / cardigans may only be worn under school blazers.

Shoes

- Smart, plain black polished leather or patent shoes with a maximum heel of 5cm. There must be no visible logos. Boots may not be worn.

Socks and Tights

- Black or dark grey ankle socks to be worn with trousers. White socks are not allowed with trousers.
- Short white or black socks to be worn with skirts. Alternatively black or natural tights, without holes/ ladders may be worn. Socks on top of tights must be plain black, not branded.

Outerwear

- Dark navy or black coat or LOGS crested storm proof coat(optional)*
- PE coats may be worn. Brightly coloured coats and hoodies (any colour) are not allowed.
- School scarf (optional)*
- Crested beanie (optional)*

Items marked with an * must be purchased from Schoolblazer. All items are compulsory unless otherwise stated



Lanyards

- Pupils must wear a school issued lanyard with their school access card at all times.

Jewellery

- Discreet jewellery consisting of a watch and a maximum of one small stud earring in each lobe is allowed. There must be absolutely no other visible piercing.
- Chains, bracelets and rings are not permitted.
- Only school issued or school approved badges may be worn.
- No visible body piercings are allowed.
- Jewellery must be removed during Games and PE. Any jewellery is the pupil's responsibility, and the school will not be held responsible for loss or theft.

Hair and Make-up

- Hair that can be tied back, must be fully tied back at all times.
- Large colourful or floral clips or accessories are not allowed.
- Extreme hairstyles are not allowed. Hair colouring should be discreet and natural.
- Hair-cuts should be no less than a grade 1.
- Excessively all over short hair is not allowed.
- It would be advisable to contact the appropriate Head of Year to discuss any drastic changes to hair style / colour beforehand.
- Only discreet make-up is allowed. No eyeliner, lipstick etc.
- Pupils will be asked to remove excess makeup.
- Nail varnish, acrylic nails or nail extensions are not permitted.
- Fake eyelashes or extension eyelashes are not allowed.



Year 10 and 11 School Uniform Dress Code

Blazer, Skirts and Trousers

- Mid Grey school blazer or fitted jacket with school coat of arms*
- Charcoal Grey trousers to be worn on the waist – acceptable style shown on School Blazer website **OR** Charcoal grey school skirt*, a choice of two styles is available. Skirts should not be rolled up and must not be shorter than 18" (as measured when worn).
- If belts are worn with trousers, these must be black with plain, unbranded buckles.

Shirt, Tie and Jumpers

- White long/short sleeved shirt with buttons to the neck, tucked in at all times with school tie Year 10 and 11* (this option is usually worn with trousers) **OR** White open necked long/short sleeved reverse blouse to be tucked in at all times to be worn without a tie (this option is usually worn with a skirt).
- Charcoal Grey 'V' neck sleeved or sleeveless jumper with maroon trim*. No other jumpers may be worn.
- School blazers must be worn at all times and school jumpers / cardigans may only be worn under school blazers. No other jumpers / cardigans may be worn.
- School blazers must be worn at all times and school jumpers may only be worn under school blazers.

Shoes

- Smart, plain black polished leather or patent shoes with a maximum heel of 5cm. There must be no visible logos. Boots may not be worn.

Socks and Tights

- Black or dark grey ankle socks to be worn with trousers. White socks are not allowed with trousers.
- Short white or black socks to be worn with skirts. Alternatively black or natural tights, without holes/ ladders may be worn. Socks on top of tights must be plain black, not branded.

Outerwear

- Dark navy or black coat or LOGS crested storm proof coat(optional)*
- PE coats may be worn. Brightly coloured coats and hoodies (any colour) are not allowed.
- School scarf (optional)*
- Crested beanie (optional)*

Items marked with an * must be purchased from Schoolblazer. All items are compulsory unless otherwise stated



Lanyards

- Pupils must wear a school issued lanyard with their school access card at all times.

Jewellery

- In addition to a watch, a single discreet item of jewellery may be worn. This may be either a necklace / chain (not 'chunky') or a bracelet or a ring.
- Up to two small earrings may be worn in each ear. Hoops can have a maximum diameter of 1.5 cm. No other visible piercings are allowed.
- Only school issued or school approved badges may be worn.
- Jewellery must be removed during Games and PE, and possibly at other times, for Health and Safety reasons. Items of jewellery are the pupil's responsibility; the school will not be held responsible for loss or theft.

Hair and Make-up

- Extreme hair styles, including facial hair are not allowed. Hair colouring should be discreet and natural.
- Long hair must be tied up for practical activities and at any time that it is considered to be a hindrance. If applicable, a hairband should be carried at all times.
- Large colourful or floral clips or accessories are not allowed.
- Hair-cuts should be no less than a grade 1.
- Excessively all over short hair is not allowed
- It would be advisable to contact the appropriate Head of Year to discuss any proposed drastic changes to hair style / colour before they are made.
- Only discreet make up is allowed. Pupils will be asked to remove excess makeup.
- Nail varnish, acrylic nails or nail extensions are not permitted
- Fake eyelashes or extension eyelashes are not allowed.



PE Kit – All Years

Tops

- LOGS white and maroon crested polo shirt*
- LOGS black and maroon crested tracksuit top*
- LOGS black crested midlayer*

Bottoms

- LOGS black shorts*
- LOGS training pant bottoms*
- LOGS skort (optional)

(Shorts are compulsory for students in all Years and skorts are optional. Shorts can be worn for all of the sports in our curriculum, and skorts are only suitable to be worn for some. Shorts must be worn for football and rugby).

Footwear

- Black and maroon long socks for games lessons*
- White sports socks for PE lessons*
- Football / rugby boots (check PE schedule to see if / when required)
- Astro shoes for hockey / football
- Trainers for indoor sports and badminton

Other Sports equipment

- LOGS black base layer top (optional)
- Black baselayer shorts / leggings (optional)
- Shin pads (compulsory)
- Gum shield (compulsory)
- LOGS sports bag (optional)
- Black and burgundy bobble hat
- LOGS cap (optional) (summer term only)

Items marked with an * are compulsory and must be purchased from Schoolblazer.

In colder weather, pupils may wear plain black base layers or leggings/skins underneath their PE kit. Leggings/skins should not be worn without shorts/skort over the top.

It is important that students wear trainers designed for sport and not fashion/lifestyle trainers - this is to ensure students have footwear that have the necessary grip, stability and cushioning which helps to prevent injuries, such as ankle sprains. In order to clarify the difference between a sports and fashion trainer, we have provided pictures below:

A key identifying feature of a fashion trainer is that they have a completely flat sole; sports trainers, on the other hand, have a defined, arch-contoured sole, which provide more support and reduce impact; this is especially important for sports that involve frequent jumping, pivoting and changes of direction at speed.
